The Global Pipeline Event

After starting as a small side event of the huge Hannover Messe trade show in 2006, the ptc rapidly evolved into Europe's premier pipeline conference and exhibition. Over the years, the conference has garnered significant attention and participation from industry leaders, experts, and professionals from around the world, and the exhibition has similarly grown in scale and prominence.

Since 2014 the ptc takes place in Berlin. From the very beginning, all technical papers are published on an open access basis via the unique ptc Pipeline Open Knowledge Base.

#### **Technological Excellence**

These sessions, conducted in six concurrent tracks, provide a deep insight into the latest developments and advancements in pipeline technology. The selection of papers is based on a quality review by the members of the ptc Advisory Committee. All papers are published after the event on an open access basis via the ptc Pipeline Open Knowledge Base.

#### **Promotion of Young Talent**

The Pipeline Technology Conference features a variety of opportunities for young people to get involved into the organization of the event and it will host different awards ceremonies for both students and young professionals. The EITEP Institute is committed to fostering the next generation of pipeline professionals and cooperates with different young pipeline professional communities from around the world.






